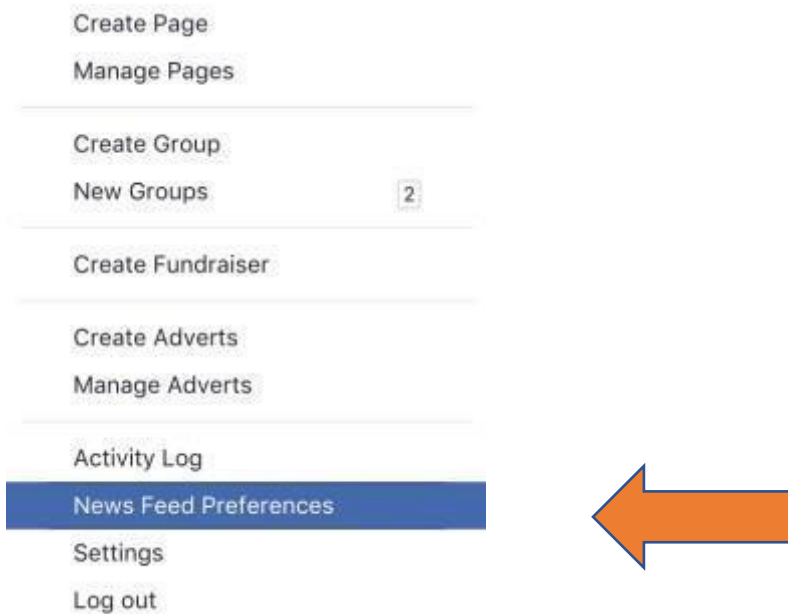


How do I ensure I see what I want to see?

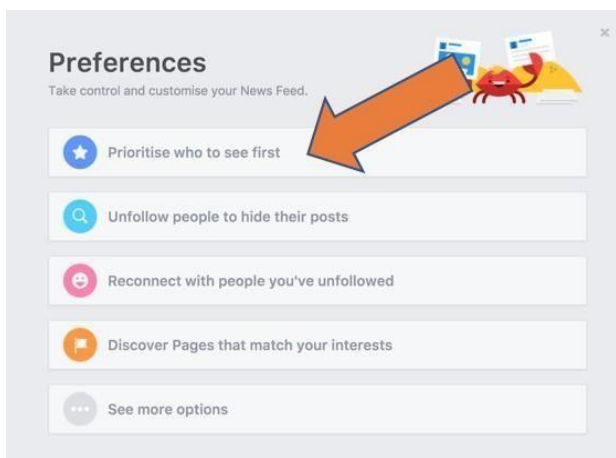
Click on the drop-down triangle found in the blue bar on the right of your Facebook account view. For mobiles go to the more area at the bottom of your screen and then click on settings.




If you look down the list you will find the option 'News Feed Preferences' – click on it.



A pop up widow will then provide you a range of options to tweak your news feed. These are worth exploring. For the moment click on 'Prioritise who to see first'.



Now you can choose, by clicking on the icon/s, what pages or friend posts you want to see first, this ensures that won't miss anything they share. A star will be added to pages and profiles you want to see first.
